- b. Evidence of Company Income Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years (2019,2020,2021);
- c. Evidence of Pension Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2022 (this requirement is only applicable to bidders whose number of staff is 15 and above);
- d. Evidence of Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2022 (this requirement is only applicable to bidders whose number of staff is 5 and above or the bidder's annual turnover is ₦50m and above);
- e. Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2022;
- f. Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31/12/2022 or valid Certificate issued by BPP;
- g. Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Border Communities Development Agency or The Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, Shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars.
- h. Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years (2019,2020,2021);
- i. Reference Letter from a reputable Commercial Bank in Nigeria indicating willingness to provide credit facilities for the execution of the project when needed.
- j. Company profile with the Curriculum Vitae of key staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic / Professional qualifications such as COREN, QSRBN, ARCON, CORBON etc.);
- k. Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects.
